The Bible Reveals Five Important Realities About Heaven:

1. Heaven is an actual _____

John 14:1-3 "¹ Do not let your heart be troubled; believe in God, believe also in Me [Jesus]. ² In My Father's house are many dwelling places; if it were not so, I would have told you; for I go to prepare a place for you. ³ If I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself, that where I am, there you may be also."

Acts 1:9-11 "⁹ And after He [Jesus] had said these things, He was lifted up while they were looking on, and a cloud received Him out of their sight. ¹⁰ And as they were gazing intently into the sky while He was going, behold, two men in white clothing stood beside them. ¹¹ They also said, 'Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking into the sky? This Jesus, who has been taken up from you into heaven, will come in just the same way as you have watched Him go into heaven."

2. Heaven is both an immediate and an ultimate _____

Luke 23:43 "And He [Jesus] said to him, 'Truly I say to you, today you shall be with Me in Paradise."

Revelation 22:1-3a "¹ Then he showed me a river of the water of life, clear as crystal, coming from the throne of God and of the Lamb, ² in the middle of its street. On either side of the river was the tree of life, bearing twelve kinds of fruit, yielding its fruit every month; and the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations. ³ There will no longer be any curse..."

Colossians 1:18 "He is also head of the body, the church; and He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, so that He Himself will come to have first place in everything."

John 11:25-26 " 25 Jesus said to her, 'I am the resurrection and the life; he who believes in Me will live even if he dies, 26 and everyone who lives and believes in Me will never die..."

2 Corinthians 5:9-10 "⁹ Therefore, we also have as our ambition, whether at home or absent, to be pleasing to Him. ¹⁰ For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may be recompensed for his deeds in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad."

Revelation 20:12 "And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and books were opened; and another book was opened, which is the book of life; and the dead were judged from the things which were written in the books, according to their deeds."

Revelation 20:15 "And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire."

Luke 16:25 "Child, remember that during your life you received your good things..."

John 11:25-26 "²⁵ Jesus said to her, 'I am the resurrection and the life; he who believes in Me will live even if he dies, ²⁶ and everyone who lives and believes in Me will never die. Do you believe this?"

John 3:16 "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life."

Isaiah 64:6a "For all of us have become like one who is unclean, and all our righteous deeds are like a filthy garment..."

2 Corinthians 5:21 "He [God] made Him [Jesus] who knew no sin to be sin on our behalf, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him."
