HOW TO BE A CHRISTIAN WITHOUT BEING RELIGIOUS – Romans 2:17-3:9

**Introduction:** Religion has sent more people to Hell than any other factor. We will discover why that is true in today's passage.

### I. Three Excuses of Religious People (Romans 2:17-29)

Romans 2:17 "But if you bear the name 'Jew' and rely upon the Law, and boast in God,"

### A. Excuse #1: "Examine My Religious Heritage." (Romans 2:17a)

Romans 2:17a "But if you bear the name 'Jew'..."

John 8:37-40, 44 "<sup>37</sup>'I know that you are Abraham's offspring; yet you seek to kill Me, because My word has no place in you. <sup>38</sup>I speak the things which I have seen with My Father; therefore you also do the things which you heard from your father.' <sup>39</sup>They answered and said to Him, 'Abraham is our father.' Jesus said to them, 'If you are Abraham's children, do the deeds of Abraham. <sup>40</sup>But as it is, you are seeking to kill Me, a man who has told you the truth, which I heard from God; this Abraham did not do. <sup>44</sup>You are of your father the devil, and you want to do the desires of your father. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. Whenever he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own nature; for he is a liar, and the father of lies."'

# HOW TO BE A CHRISTIAN WITHOUT BEING RELIGIOUS

Galatians 3:7-9 "<sup>7</sup> Therefore, be sure that it is those who are of faith who are sons of Abraham. <sup>8</sup> And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel beforehand to Abraham, saying, 'All the nations shall be blessed in you.' <sup>9</sup>So then those who are of faith are blessed with Abraham, the believer."

B. Excuse #2: "Look At My Biblical Knowledge." (Romans 2:17b-24)

Romans 2:17b "...and rely upon the Law, and boast in God,"

Romans 3:1-2 "<sup>1</sup>Then what advantage has the Jew? Or what is the benefit of circumcision? <sup>2</sup>Great in every respect. First of all, that they were entrusted with the oracles of God."

Romans 2:18-24 "<sup>18</sup> and know His will, and approve the things that are essential, being instructed out of the Law, <sup>19</sup> and are confident that you yourself are a guide to the blind, a light to those who are in darkness, <sup>20</sup> a corrector of the foolish, a teacher of the immature, having in the Law the embodiment of knowledge and of the truth, <sup>21</sup> you, therefore, who teach another, do you not teach yourself? You who preach that one should not steal, do you steal? <sup>22</sup> You who say that one should not commit adultery, do you commit adultery? You who abhor idols, do you rob temples? <sup>23</sup> You who boast in the Law, through your breaking the Law, do you dishonor God? <sup>24</sup> For 'The name of God is blasphemed among the Gentiles because of you,' just as it is written."

C. Excuse #3: "Watch My Religious <u>Works</u>." (Romans 2:25)

# HOW TO BE A CHRISTIAN WITHOUT BEING RELIGIOUS

Romans 2:25 "For indeed circumcision is of value, if you practice the Law; but if you are a transgressor of the Law, your circumcision has become uncircumcision."

Colossians 2:11 "And in Him you were also circumcised with a circumcision made without hands, in the removal of the body of the flesh by the circumcision of Christ;"

Romans 2:28-29 "<sup>28</sup> For he is not a Jew who is one outwardly; neither is circumcision that which is outward in the flesh. <sup>29</sup> But he is a Jew who is one inwardly; and circumcision is that which is of the heart, by the Spirit, not by the letter; and his praise is not from men, but from God."

### II. Genuine Righteousness vs. Empty Religion

### A. Righteousness Results in <u>Works</u>, Religion Results in <u>Words</u>.

Romans 2:7-10 "<sup>7</sup> to those who by perseverance in doing good seek for glory and honor and immortality, eternal life; <sup>8</sup> but to those who are selfishly ambitious and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, wrath and indignation. <sup>9</sup> There will be tribulation and distress for every soul of man who does evil, of the Jew first and also of the Greek, <sup>10</sup> but glory and honor and peace to every man who does good, to the Jew first and also to the Greek."

# B. Righteousness is Based on God's <u>Effort</u>, Religion is Based on Our <u>Efforts</u>.
