Introduction: A recent survey asked a cross-section of Americans, "If you could ask God any question, what would it be?" The number one response was "Why does God allow suffering in the world?" Today we will discover how the apostle Paul answers that age-old question.

Romans 8:17 "and if children, heirs also, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with *Him* in order that we may also be glorified with *Him*."

Romans 8:18 "For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory that is to be revealed to us."

Romans 8:19, 22 ¹⁹ "For the anxious longing of the creation waits eagerly for the revealing of the sons of God." ²² "For we know that the whole creation groans and suffers the pains of childbirth together until now."
