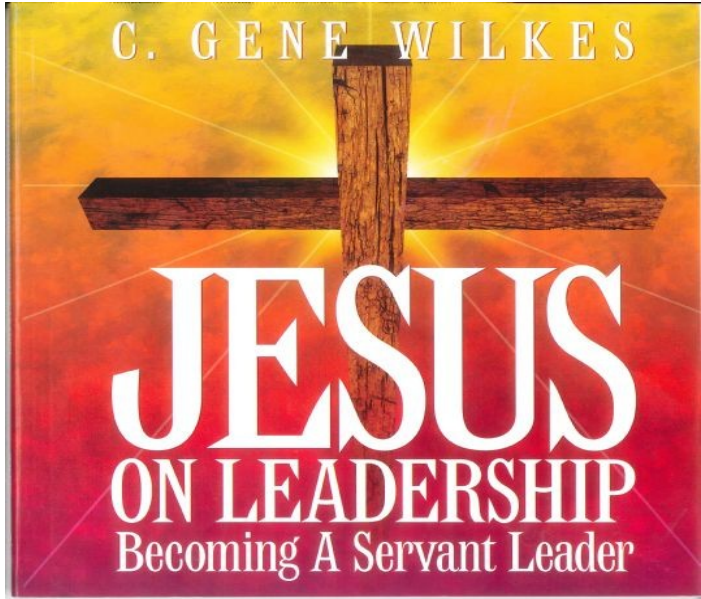

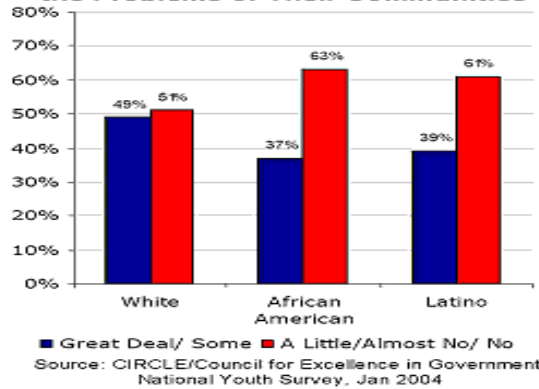

# LEADERSHIP TEAMS **LEAD 365**

**“First- Step Team”**- Students will meet in the HS Room and greet visitors as they come into Sunday School or Collision. A few students will be at the bottom of the Spurgeon/Harris Building directing new students to the ninth floor. Also, students will make any new student feel welcomed to the First Dallas Student Ministry. Each host will look for someone of the same gender and try to get to know them, introduce them to other people in the ministry, and make our guests feel comfortable. We ask that those on the “First-Step” team sit with new guests during Sunday School and walk them to their small group class.

**Worship Ministry**- students will be trained to lead in worship, audio, and visuals on Sunday mornings. (See Tyler Williams for auditions at [twilliams@firstdallas.org](mailto:twilliams@firstdallas.org))

**Prayer Team**- students will meet before Sunday School and pray specifically for First Dallas Students. Students will also be given a guide for our many other prayer needs.

**Blitz/ Connection Team**- students will report each Sunday how many people they invited to church that week from school. Students will also be given a call-list each week to call new visitors at some point during the week. Students will also arrive on Sunday mornings to write cards, emails, and text message students who previously visited our ministry.
